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Main Objectives: Harnessing Processes, Documents and Data for Better Business Outcomes



With a newfound energy and desire to innovate, the clinical team wanted technology solutions that would modernize their department and enhance its contribution to the company's mission and values.

One of the primary objectives was to standardize and digitalize workflows. This would help the department retain knowledge, be more transparent, and have access to important data in real-time. Ultimately this would allow internal and external teams to work more efficiently.

Another goal was to enable the leadership team to easily and accurately report on key performance indicators (KPIs). Historically, the clinical research team had struggled to establish and monitor KPIs because data was dispersed across systems and not easily accessible. This team aspired to standardize and digitalize their processes, documents, and data. Doing this would enable their teams to reduce time spent on manual tasks, be more resilient and agile amidst changing market dynamics, and increase transparency and visibility across their workflows.

In Practice: Expert Implementation, Rapid Acceptance and Adoption Has Lead to Early Successes

In hindsight, the clinical team's timing couldn't have been better. They began implementing Veeva's software and onboarding teams in 2020. The new ETMF system enabled the department's remote team to stay focused and productive despite the change in the situation due to the pandemic.

The eTMF system has been shown to be intuitive and user-friendly, and teams were happy to integrate the tool into their workflows. A critical success factor was that the teams bought into transitioning to the new system and liked using the new software. To ensure that their eTMF solution was easily accessible, the team employed a single sign-on feature, which made it easy for everyone to make the most of the software with as little downtime as possible.

While the clinical research unit continues to onboarding users as new studies begin, results from the first few years have shown broad acceptance of the eTMF solution, with positive feedback from active users. With this new suite of technology solutions, the whole department is moving to a higher level of quality. Veeva's solutions have also shown significant value when onboarding a new site, as clinical research associates can upload their own documentation to the Vault platform and go through the process more efficiently.

One of the standout features based on user feedback thus far has been e-signatures. Prior to Veeva, team members were chasing manual signatures, printing and scanning documents across countries, and generally taking up a lot of overhead time getting manual documents finalized and filed. The ability to capture compliant e-signatures helps managers review and complete the approval process quicker, freeing up their time for other things. Putting aside old-fashioned paper-based systems and building a unified solution has enabled them to focus on what really matters.
